What could we to do improve?

- Always close the doors and windows .
- Switch off the heater when it's too hot.
- Every teacher must turn interactive boards off when they finish classes.

Topic: Water

	There are some dripping taps around the school.
	Taps sometimes get left on .
	There is only one school which collects rainwater for watering plants.
	Students don't understand WHY it is important not to waste water .

What could we to do improve?

- Check for dripping taps and ask to be repaired.
- Collect rainwater / put buckets in the school grounds to collect rainwater.
- Prepare stickers reminding to close the taps
- Educate whole school community about importance of saving water prepare lesson plan and conduct lesson at school, make posters with students, show them at school corridors, involve students in preparing eco -code, measure water the amount of water saved together, organize school trip to water treatment plant

Section 3

<u>Topic</u>: Healty Living

<u>STRENGTHS</u>	<u>WEAKNESSES</u>
Children can drink fresh water during the school day.	Schools don't encourage healthy food in packed lunches.
Schools have a gardening club.	Children don't have healthy snacks at school.

What could we to do improve?
